

IDESST History Presented by Mike Moyle

Please join us at **7:00pm** this coming **Wednesday**, **February 17**, for a presentation on Sausalito's Portuguese history by Mike Moyle. The presentation will be via **Zoom**, which will be accessible that evening via the link at the bottom of this post.

Mike, a Sausalito resident and an IDESST member, has been leading the effort over the last few years to research and preserve the history of our organization and of the Portuguese community in southern Marin. In 2014 he helped to create the Sausalito Portuguese Heritage Walking Tour, a tour with 33 stops in and around Sausalito that highlight our area's Portuguese heritage. A guidebook for that tour can be downloaded without charge from the History page on the IDESST website (<u>https://idesst.wildapricot.org/history</u>).

Since then Mike has continued his research, in many cases sharing his findings in posts here on this page. Most recently he has been involved in a project to document the hundreds of dairies have been in Marin, many of them, in particular those in southern Marin, that were operated by members of our organization. 


Sausalito resident & author Dr. Martin Terplan retired from private practice in 2013, but has continued to teach and has focused on geriatric medicine.


