LIBRARY BOOKS - DELIVERED!

The Sausalito Library and the City of Sausalito's CARSS program have joined forces to create a new **home delivery service of library materials**. This FREE program is open to residents of Sausalito and the floating homes community who are aged 60 or more and to younger adults with a disability. The service is available Monday - Friday, 10:00 am - 2:00 pm. For more information call program coordinator Augie Webb 415-289-4121.

Age Friendly Permit Program is Here!

In Sausalito, falls at home are the number one reason emergency medical services are called.

To help Sausalito residents age 60 or older and younger adults with a disability improve their home environment, the City's Community Development Department joined with Age Friendly Sausalito to create the Age Friendly Home Adaptation Grant Program which will allow eligible homeowners and renters (who have attained landlord approval), to make accessibility improvements to their place of residence with a **reduced fee or no-cost building permit.**

A full list of eligible modifications is available from the building permits counter. A few examples include: stair elevator lifts, ramps to entries, handrails, wider doors, bathroom improvements such as adjustable height counters, bracing in walls for grab bars at tubs, showers, and toilets, no-curb showers.
