

Supervisors to Consider Drought Emergency

San Rafael, CA – The Marin County Board of Supervisors has invited representatives from the county's two largest water districts to <u>provide a public update[PDF]</u> about local drought conditions during its May 18 meeting. During the session, the Board also will consider declaring a local emergency and imminent threat of disaster.

Marin Water[External], the municipal water district serving the majority of water customers in Marin County, will discuss the drought not long after the meeting begins online at 9 a.m. along with an official from the North Marin Water District[External] (NMWD), which serves Novato and some communities in West Marin. Both districts have declared water shortage emergencies and enacted mandatory conservation measures.







## **American Women Quarters Program**

The American Women Quarters Program is a four-year program that celebrates the accomplishments and contributions made by women to the development and history of our country. Beginning in 2022, and continuing through 2025, the U.S. Mint will issue up to five new reverse designs each year. The obverse of each coin will maintain a likeness of George Washington, but be different from the design used during the previous quarter program. The American Women Quarters Program is authorized by the Circulating Collectible Coin Redesign Act of 2020 (Public Law 116-330).

The public is invited to submit recommendations for potential honorees through the web portal established by the <u>National Women's History Museum</u>. The Secretary of the Treasury selects the honorees following consultation with the Smithsonian Institution's American Women's History Initiative, the National Women's History Museum, and the Congressional Bipartisan Women's Caucus.






At its meeting on May 11, the City Council voiced unanimous support for a new mural and improved lighting for the pedestrian walkway of the **Highway 101 underpass** between Sausalito and Marin City.

The project is being led by a steering committee of local organizations that includes Marin City Performing Stars, Arts Plus Foundation, the Sausalito Foundation, and Sausalito Beautiful. The organizers of "Tunnel Project: All Our Children United" will seek private funding for the work, which will require approval from Caltrans.

As designed by local artist Raylene Gorum, the mural would feature the stenciled handprints of children who live or study in Marin City or Sausalito, with handprints increasing in size as they move up the wall to a height of approximately six feet. Rendered in a "sunrise to sunset" color palette, the mural would cover the entire 160-foot length of the tunnel, plus 75 feet on each side.
