

'Massive' coral reef taller than the Empire State Building discovered in Australia A "massive" new reef measuring 500 meters (about 1,600 feet) has been discovered in Australia's Great Barrier Reef, making it taller than some of the world's highest skyscrapers.

Scientists found the detached reef, which is the first to be discovered in more than 120 years, in waters off North Queensland while on an expedition aboard research vessel Falkor, ocean research organization Schmidt Ocean Institute announced Monday.

The reef was first discovered on October 20, as scientists completed an underwater mapping of the seafloor of the northern Great Barrier Ree

## Compare Medicare health and drug plans

Just as your health care needs can change from year to year, so do Medicare plans. And not all plans offer the same benefits. Open Enrollment is your chance to <u>review your Medicare coverage options</u>, and find the best fit for you.

## re are some things to consider when shopping for Medicare coverage:

- Check if your doctors are still in-network and your prescriptions are on the plan's list of covered drugs, or "formulary."
- With historically low plan premiums, be sure to also consider the plan's deductible and other out-of-pocket costs that factor into a plan's total costs.
- Some plans offer extra benefits, like vision, hearing, or dental coverage, that could help meet your needs in 2021.

Visit Medicare.gov through December 7 to compare plans and make any changes. If you decide to change plans, your new coverage will start January 1.

- OR Volunteers will pick up your ballot at your door and take it to the Ballot Box in Marin City. For it to be counted on election night, it must be in the Ballot Box 3 days before.
