#### Marin Covid Information as of December 7

- 21 people were hospitalized with the virus, which was the highest number in Marin's hospitals in more than three months. Six patients are currently in the ICU. According to county data, the number of people currently hospitalized with the virus has risen by almost 91% over the past week and nearly 163% over the past two weeks.
- There were 38 new cases in Marin on December 7 and 467 active cases in Marin. Likely many more cases to come this week and in the weeks to come.
- We have gone past the adjusted case rate of 7 cases per 100,000 population.
- While Marin County hospitals are not yet completely filled, we are part of Region 2 which means we must handle overflow from other neighboring counties.
- We will soon have non Marin County patients in all three hospitals.
   Marin's hospitals are only moderately-sized. And all hospital beds could soon be filled.

#### **Demographics of Cases:**

- Dr. Santora reported that 90% of current coronavirus transmission in Marin is from "voluntary choices" (gathering with others who do not live in the same household).
- Locally, it is no longer care facilities and a subsection of the Hispanic population in San Rafael that are driving the surge in cases.
- There are COVID-19 cases in every community in Marin. At last count (12/7/20), there were 486 known COVID-19 cases in the Southern Marin area: 218 in greater Mill Valley; 49 in Marin City; 85 in Sausalito; 110 in Tiburon; and 24 in Belvedere.

This week's updates: • "Thank You Sausalito" Day has been postponed due to shelter-in-place orders. We look forward to celebrating with you at a safer time. • Senior


