


An Undulating Sculpture Recreates Hokusai's 'Great Wave' in 50,000 LEGO Pieces

Japan-based artist <u>Jumpei Mitsui</u> is one of just 21 <u>LEGO Certified</u>

<u>Professionals</u> in the world—this means his full-time job is to create artworks with the plastic building blocks—and is the youngest of the renowned group. He's fulfilled this title most recently with a sculptural recreation of Katsushika Hokusai's "<u>The Great Wave off Kanagawa</u>." During the course of 400 hours, Mitsui snapped together 50,000 cobalt and white LEGO into an undulating wave that mimics the original woodblock print.
