## COVID VACCINATION NEWS

Marin County is currently in Phase 1A of vaccine distribution based on a model developed by the CDC Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices and the California Department of Public Health (CDPH). Those currently being vaccinated include employees in a wide range of health care fields, from nurses and paramedics to hospice and home health care workers.

Phase 1A is expected to last through late January and will be followed by Phase 1B. This phase will continue into early February and will include individuals 65 and over and those in work settings that are particularly susceptible to virus transmission.

Phase 1C is slated to begin in late February or early March and will include those 50 and over, those with high-risk underlying health conditions, and additional workers in essential business sectors.

Phase 1B Tier 2 is 65-74

Phase 1B Tier 3 is 50-64

Phase 2 is projected for late spring and will include those with lower risk health conditions.

Phase 3 will see the immunization of the remaining population and is anticipated for summer 2021.

Marin Public Health says that this model for vaccine distribution is subject to change from week to week based on additional recommendations and definitions from CDC and CDPH. The timeline is tentative and dependent on vaccine supply allocations.

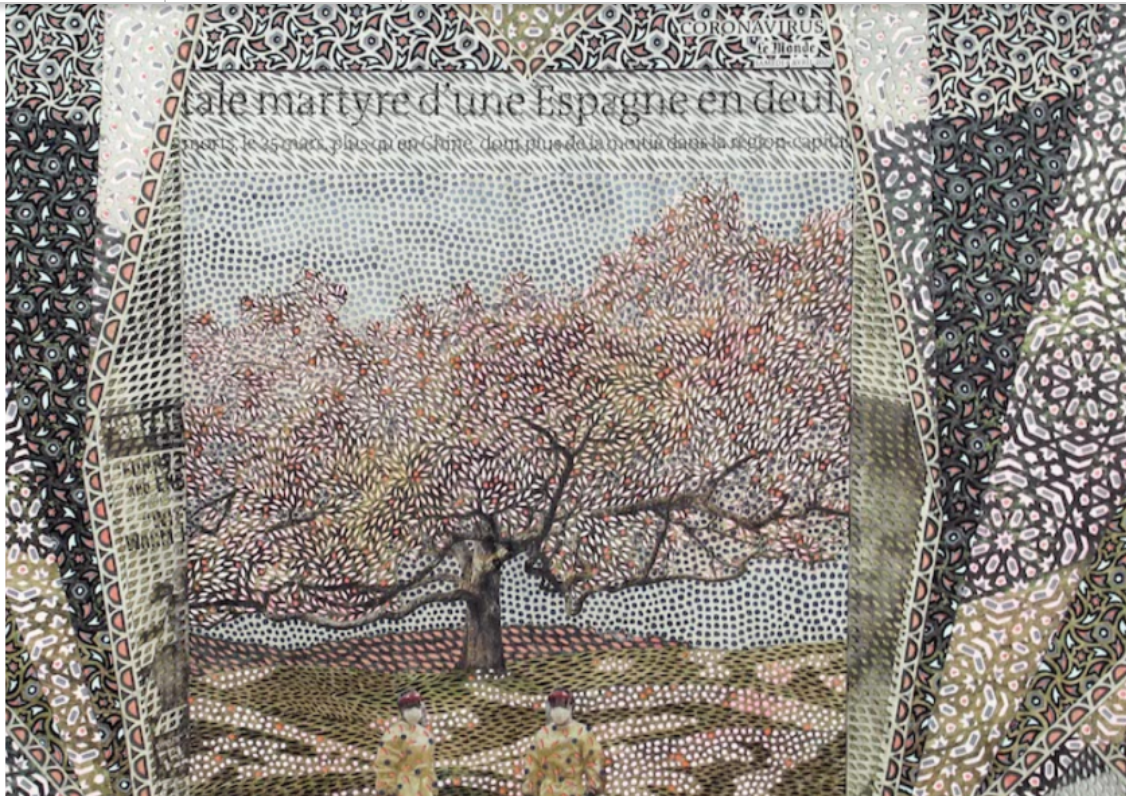
